

NOTICE OF DECISION

IN THE MATTER OF THE COMMONS ACT 2006 AND OF REGULATION 43 OF THE COMMONS REGISTRATION (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2014 AND IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION TO DECLARE ENTITLEMENT TO A RIGHT OF COMMON, COMMON LAND UNIT CL146, KNOWN AS REDMOSS FELL, QUERNMORE (APPLICATION REF NO. CA026)

Notice is hereby given that Lancashire County Council as the Registration Authority, at a meeting held on 26th July 2017 considered the application by Mr John Metcalfe ("the Applicant") for a Declaration of Entitlement to be recorded in the Commons Register in accordance with Regulation 43 of The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 ('the Regulations').

No representations have been made in objection to the application and the application and the proposed amendment complies with the requirements of the Act and the Regulations.

The Registration Authority has decided to accept the application in full and make the appropriate amendment to the rights section of the register of common land to record a declaration of the Applicant's entitlement to exercise part of the right attached to Upper Brow Top Farm, Quernmore. The part right referred to is a right to graze 22 sheep over the whole of the land comprised in register unit CL146 known as Redmoss Fell in the Parish of Quernmore, Lunesdale Rural District, Lancashire.
