

**NOTICE OF DECISION

DECLARE ENTITLEMENT TO A RIGHT OF COMMON
COMMON LAND UNIT CL193, KNOWN AS COLLOWAY
AND OVERTON MARSHES
(APPLICATION REF NO. CA015)**

Notice is hereby given that Lancashire County Council as the Registration Authority, at a meeting held on the 2nd October 2012, considered the application by Mr Alan John Bargh ('the Applicant') for a Declaration of Entitlement to be recorded in the Commons Register in accordance with Regulation 44 of the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2008 ('the Regulations').

No representations have been made in objection to the application and the application and the proposed amendment complies with the requirements of the Act and the Regulations.

The Registration Authority has decided to accept the application and make the appropriate amendment to the rights section of the register of common land to record a declaration of the Applicant's entitlement to exercise part of the right attached to Manor House Farm, Overton. The part right referred to is a right to graze 33 cattle over the whole of the land comprised in register unit CL193 and known as Colloway and Overton Marshes in the Parish of Overton, Lancaster Rural District.
