

NOTICE OF DECISION

IN THE MATTER OF THE COMMONS ACT 2006 AND OF REGULATION 44 OF THE COMMONS REGISTRATION (ENGLAND) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2009 AND IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION TO DECLARE ENTITLEMENT TO A RIGHT OF COMMON, COMMON LAND UNIT CL12, KNOWN AS PARLICK FELL, CHIPPING (APPLICATION REF NO. CA020)

Notice is hereby given that Lancashire County Council as the Registration Authority, at a meeting held on 1st July 2013 considered the application by Mr Paul Smith on behalf of the trustees of St Bartholomew's Church in Chipping ("the Applicants") for a Declaration of Entitlement to be recorded in the Commons Register in accordance with Regulation 44 of The Commons Registration (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2009 ('the Regulations').

No representations have been made in objection to the application and the application and the proposed amendment complies with the requirements of the Act and the Regulations.

The Registration Authority has decided to accept the application in full and make the appropriate amendment to the rights section of the register of common land to record a declaration of the Applicants' entitlement to exercise part of the right attached to Abbot Barn Farm and Nickens Field, Chipping. The part right referred to is a right to graze 12 sheep over the whole of the land comprised in register unit CL12 and known as Parlick Fell in the Parish of Chipping.
